ENTRY is open to all artists in Albury, Wodonga and the surrounding region
Artists can enter up to 3 works, 2D or 3D, up to a maximum size of 1.2 x 1.2 metres,
framed works must be ready to hang, with D-rings

ELIGIBILITY

- Artists are NOT required to be a member of Gateway Gallery to enter.
- All framed works must be fitted with two (2) D-rings on the back and must not exceed the maximum size of 1.2 x 1.2 metres.
- Artwork must be clearly labelled with artist's name and phone number, title and price of work. Artwork Entry Labels are available on our website or you can use your own labels.
- **Artwork must not have been exhibited at Gateway Gallery in the past 12 months.**
- By entering, you are confirming that your artwork will be exhibited for the duration of the exhibition from **17 February to 4 April 2026**.
- By entering, you are confirming that you are the creator and owner of the entered artwork.
- Artists at all stages of their career are encouraged to enter but must live in our local regional area and be aged 18 years or older.
- All artworks will be available for purchase throughout the exhibition and prices must include the 30% commission rate payable to Gateway Gallery.

- The work exceeds the specified size limit.

- The work has not been labelled, either with an attached label or handwritten on the back of the work.
- The work could be considered offensive in terms of pornographic content, character denigration, racial or religious prejudice.
- The work is not of sufficient artistic or technical merit.

Please note: Artists will be refunded their entry fee/s for any of their work/s that are not included in this exhibition.
